General Departmental Information

Students interested in pursuing an area of scholarly inquiry which falls outside the purview of an established academic department or program of the University may apply for admission to the Individual Studies program. This academic program offers students an opportunity to develop, under the guidance of faculty advisors, a major which meets their specific needs. The program is available in the Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Music and Bachelor of Science degrees. Major areas of study are typically interdisciplinary.

Detailed written procedures and advice about preparing a proposal are available from the office of the Associate Vice President for Undergraduate Studies. The proposal must include a title, statement of purpose, a listing of courses which comprise the major, and support from a faculty advisor. The Course of Study should include courses from at least two separate subject areas and total at least 60 credits. All proposal materials must be submitted to the Associate Vice President for Undergraduate Studies at least three quarters prior to anticipated graduation, unless otherwise stipulated by the Associate Vice President for Undergraduate Studies. Proposals are subject to the review and approval of an advisory committee which meets quarterly. Application forms, guidelines and policies are available in the Office of the Associate Vice President for Undergraduate Studies, Barge 303.
