POLICY

The Alumni Association provides a \$1000.00 award to the recipient of the Departmental Scholarship. The recipient will be recognized during Homecoming weekend. Departmental involvement is required for all applications. A maximum of two nominations from a department or course of study will be accepted.

The criteria for selection will be based on the student's: (not in order of importance)

- Academics
- Contribution to department
- Motivation
- Organizational and leadership activities
- Recommendations by department and faculty
- Demonstrated financial need

The application deadline is March 6. The Scholarship Committee of the Central Washington University Alumni Association Board of Director's will select the recipients.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a junior or senior by October when the award is presented
- Must have declared a major in the department which is nominating him/her
- Must be able to demonstrate academic and leadership abilities
- Must have completed three consecutive quarters at Central
- Must be a full time student at the time of nomination and when the award is presented
- Applicants may be either male or female and of any religion or ethnic origin

NOMINATION PROCEDURES

The nomination is originated by the faculty and chair of an academic department. The form is to be completed and turned in by the department. The association recommends that the nominee be called in to meet with a faculty member. The faculty member will then inform the candidate that the department is nominating her/him for the departmental scholarship. The student can then assist the faculty member in completing the form.

Students are asked to write a brief statement reflecting their current educational status and short-term goals. Please answer the question, "How will this scholarship assist you?"

Scholarship nomination forms are available in the office of Alumni Relations, Barge Hall 214.

Letters of recommendation from the Department Chair and department faculty member must accompany this form. The nominated student must attach a written statement.

ACADEMICS – Please note student’s G.P.A. in major area of study and, if possible, G.P.A. in minor if pertinent to show departmental involvement.

MOTIVATION – Probability of achieving individual goals. Comments on student’s reason for being in this major, or more specifically, his/her sincerity of purpose are important factors in determining motivation. Discuss with nominee.

CONTRIBUTION TO DEPARTMENT – Offices held, volunteer help, research activities, individual studies, seminars, etc.
