1. The meeting was called to order @ 9:00 AM by Buck Evans, Director.
2. The meeting minutes from October 27, 2006 were unavailable.
3. The agenda for the February 2, 2007 meeting was approved.
4. Good News: Stacey Locke shared school news from Yakima SD. Lisa Muchlinski brought us some family pictures – she has a new baby. Dr. Alberta Thyfault mentioned that all her students were doing well. Cinco Delgado is in a Doctorate program @ SPU. Dr. Jack McPherson informed us about his daughter, Jackie. She was seriously hurt in a sledding accident. But, she is recovering amazingly quick and hopes to be back in school soon. Dr. Henry Williams gave the Board some background information about himself. He, also, shared about the Ed. Admin. search committee. The committee is currently working through sixteen (16) applications. Dr. Steve Schmitz echoed Dr. Williams and talked about the ACP needs and how this relates to the search. Dr. Jim Pappas will be teaching the EDAD 581 this Spring, 2007. He is supervising Interns, advising Master students, the Director of Academic Service Learning, and on Spring Break will be taking a group of CWU students to Greece. Buck Evans has 22 students in his EDAD 580 class – “great group of students” says Buck. Dr. Kris Brynildsen-Smith shared some family news. She, also, mentioned that her school is growing rapidly.
5. DOE Chair’s Report: Dr. Steve Schmitz talked about the DOE’s responsibility to the ACP. He mentioned that NCATE will not review the program, but the SBE will.

- 6. PEAB Business/Information:**
  - a. Intern Report: Jack McPherson has four (4) Interns; Jim Pappas has three (3) Interns, Buck has three (3) Interns, Alberta Thyfault has two (2) Interns. All Interns seem to be doing OK. Our next Intern meeting will be February 9, 2007 in Ellensburg/Des Moines and connected DE.
  - b. Pro-Cert. Program: Buck Evans informed the PEAB that the State is requiring all Principals/Program Administrators to be continuing their education in a Pro-Cert. Program. He has written a proposal for the Board to review and hopefully approve. Buck will then present this proposal to the Dean-CEPS. Discussion followed. All the paperwork for the Pro-Cert Program needs to be submitted to the State Standards Board by May, 2007. This program will start Fall, 2007. PEAB supports Buck's proposal for a Pro-Cert. Program here at CWU.
  - c. New PEAB Member: The Board needs to replace Dr. Harry Vanikiotis, Superintendent-East Wenatchee. The new member should be a member of WASA. Discussion followed. Buck told the PEAB to submit names of interest to him.
- 7. Other Business:**
  - a. Internship Application: It was brought to the attention of the PEAB, that some students eligible for their Internship were missing the March 1<sup>st</sup> deadline. Because some school districts require Interns to apply and be interviewed, the dates of deadlines were crossing over each other and being missed. Discussion followed. The Board decided to keep the deadline at March 1<sup>st</sup>, but will review late Internship applications on an individual basis with recommendation from the Director.
