Minutes (April 21, 2008)

1. The meeting was called to order at 8:55 AM by Michelle Price, Chair
2. Good News: Dennis is doing a study with the parents and students of the Discovery Program which is an alternative program for Ellensburg middle school students. Michelle is asking for bids for their new middle school in Moses Lake and the school district has doubled the size of their property for future growth. Ben reported that the Columbia School District has a declining enrollment this year. He has just accepted a position as superintendent of Central Valley School District. Cinco also has a declining enrollment which caused the release of some administrators. Cinco is starting his doctoral program and his daughter turns 4 today. Alberta stated that the 2632 law has passed which will train school personnel to be able to handle anaphylactic shock and allergy related problems within the school. This law comes at the anniversary of Nate Walters' death. Shelley reported that the bid has been accepted for the construction of a new middle school and they are in the midst of WASAL testing.
3. The meeting minutes from February 1, 2008 were approved.
4. Chair's Report by Dennis stating that Henry has been working very hard to develop data especially addressing the Standard V for the upcoming state visit and supervisors were asked to pull data looking for results from their interns for this data compilation. See handouts of reports.

Discussion on the other text or focus in teaching interns their vision so that it is not just a statement but an action – how they are going to implement the vision. The intern meetings changed from the emphasis on input to what is the impact they are having on student learning. The last intern meeting had interns presenting what their successes/challenges have been during their internship. Journal writing and reflection writing is built in to all of our Ed Admin courses.

Ben suggested that the following be addressed in our courses or a summer seminar: Teach interns how to tell their story. We ask them to tell their story but not how.

Discussion took place on the various text and ways to accomplish this suggestion. Dennis and Alberta will follow-up on this suggestion and bring their recommendation to the next meeting. This course/seminar could be open to all not just the Ed Admin students.

CTL Program Report handout was reviewed. Alberta asked why the program administrators past 25 years report was not included in this report. If the rumor regarding the program administration portion being dropped is true notification to PEAB needs to be done.

5. PEAB members met with State Review members.
6. Next meeting will be Friday, June 27, 2008 in Ellensburg, WA unless an emergency meeting is called before that time to review applications. PEAB will look at LiveText at the next meeting.
