

## **SP PEAB - 11/16/2002**

Members present: Anderson, Jensen-Taber, Johnson, Pye-Carter, and Rasplica.

The major focus of this supplemental meeting was to review a draft copy of the interim report to be submitted to NASP in February for program approval of the School Psychology Training Program at CWU. The draft document was reviewed, and recommendations were made to strengthen and broaden the report. Specific suggestions were made concerning use of rubrics for student evaluation, PEAB review of candidates for initial certification, case study evaluations in specific courses and practica and internship experiences. These recommendations are to be addressed in the final document which will be shared with PEAB members in February.

The second topic of discussion focused on a letter that Gene received from Gail Hasbrouck, School Psychologist for the Yak8ima School District and President of the Washington State Association of School Psychologists (WSASP). The letter chastised Gene for apparently not following through on some information with the PEAB and members had not seen any relevance to the information. Gene was also accused of eating a meal at the WSASP conference that he had not paid for. There are several individuals who attended the conference that will state otherwise. Finally, and the reason that the letter was shared with the PEAB, a paragraph in the letter contained offensive, sexually explicit comments. Gene expressed his desire to consult with PEAB members as to what action, if any, he should take. PEAB members unanimously condemned the content of the letter and made several suggestions including contacting the University attorney, seeking his own council, and filing an ethical complaint with the Yakima School District, NASP and OSPI.

Finally, Gene gave a report pertaining to new students in the Program as well as to current interns. All students and interns are performing adequately.
