

SP PEAB - 05/30/2003

Members present: Keith Mars, Cindy Jacobsen, Gene Johnson, Al Albertson.
The meeting was called to order at 9:00.

1. NASP Certification: CWU just had the NASP five-year interim report. There will be no news until June 20th. Gene will hold off completing the annual report to the state until that arrives.
2. NASP Ethics: Gene has not heard anything from the NASP Ethics Board regarding Gail Hasbruck and her verbal attacks on colleagues. The complaint was discussed, but there is little information coming from either the NASP or WSASP Ethics Committees. This may be due to a delay in the Ethics Committee timelines. The issue may have only been brought up at the NASP Convention and the timelines begun at the time, Gene has discussed with the Director of Special Education in Yakima the prospect of having an intern in the Yakima School District next year and his desire that Gail should not have contact with this intern.
3. CWU: CWU has 12 interns going out in the fall. At this point they have all been placed in paying positions. Next year there are eight people who are enrolled in the program. It is not known whether all of these applicants will all attend in the fall.
4. Candidates: Today there are three initial candidates and one continuing candidate. Tina Cox-Andros, Katie Fulton, Janel Tuttle, and Rhonda Palmquist (who is the continuing candidate).
5. Next Year: Keith doesn't know where he will be next year, and therefore, our meeting place is undetermined at this time. Keith will have to take all the PEAB files home.
6. Certification: There was a certification change and all of the prerequisites were eliminated with the exception of Statistics. This took effect in December.
