

## **SP PEAB - 09/24/2004**

Members Present: Keith Mars, Cindy Jacobsen, Steve Gill, Nicole Ayers, Eric Andreassen, Al Albertson, and Bill Rasplica.

1. Meeting Dates: The following meeting dates were scheduled for this year:

2. Members: Wendy Pye-Carter and Kristi Anderson have resigned and we need new WSP and WEA members. PEAB members will look for new members.
3. New Certification WAC: OSPI will be adopting new certification WAC at the October State Board meeting. The original committee will reconvene on Monday, September 27<sup>th</sup> and review/refine the rubrics prior to making them official standards. After this meeting they will be adopted "as is". It is hoped that the rubrics will be operationally defined enough to be useful in the actual certification peer review process, as well as flexible enough to be changed (such as the discrepancy tables) when the need arises.
4. WSU School Psychology Program: Keith remarked that he has been receiving complaints from school personnel that the school psychologists from this program are not properly prepared for the job. Gene reported that he has encountered a school psychologist who had taken an intellectual assessment class online. He also reported that some students do their internship prior to the completion of the academic assessment course. It was suggested that our PEAB contact Joe Prus with NASP program approval after having discussed the concerns again with Steve Hirsch, the program chair. Eric felt that the burden of responsibility for the program should go back to Eastern Washington University, as they are the sponsors of record for the program. It was agreed that Cindy will attempt to discuss our PEAB's concerns with Steve Hirsch on September 25, 2004 at the WSASP Board Meeting.
5. Financial: We have \$400 for four meetings as reported by Bill Rasplica. Gene indicated that he was going to check into acquiring more money from OSPI.
6. Candidates: The candidates were informed of the process to obtain their continuing certification through the CWU peer review course. Twenty-five candidates were in attendance, with one of them returning from last year.
