PEAB Members in attendance: Steve Gill, Cindy Jacobsen, Eric Andreassen, Tami Jensen-Tabor, Keith Mars, Bill Rasplca, Deb Knesal, and Diane Andreassen

1. Introductions: Diane Andreassen is our new WEA representative. Her appointment is in process. Deb Knesal is our newly appointed AWSP representative. Al Albertson will also continue on the board.
2. All PEAB Meeting: Gene has submitted a grant application for the all PEAB meeting from OSPI. The amount approved may not be enough to pay for hotel rooms. This meeting will be Friday, April 22nd in Ellensburg. Keith is calling for additional agenda items aside from revising the certification rubrics/standards.
3. Continuing Candidates: Keith asked that members get the names of the continuing candidates that will be included in the June meeting by email as soon as possible. Eric volunteered to take a continuing candidate that Tami doesn't have time for.
4. New Program Approval Standards from OSPI: Each PEAB is required to do a presentation prior to August 31st of their program to the State Board under the new approval standards. Keith is concerned about what type of information will need to be included in the presentation. Often the questions are difficult to interpret. It was suggested by Eric that we contact Connie from OSPI to help interpret the questions. Discussion centered around creating a program which is practical in application and expectations.
Questions:

- #1 - It was suggested that the PEAB do a formal presentation to the faculty of CWU program
- #2 - Describe the strategies to be used to involve the PEAB in candidate selection. Keith interprets this to relate to the completion of program for initial candidates, not the students that are accepted to the program.
- #5 C All of the 5 questions imply a redesign of the programs. Keith indicated that a portfolio of student work will be included in the school psychology program.

Steve suggested that the rubrics be used as guidelines for the development of this portfolio. Some of these rubrics were discussed as being applicable, with the students told which courses these requirements will be utilized in. This could be a part of the inservice to the faculty. The question is this beyond what occurs on the internship or is it data taken during their entire program at Central? This also might include follow-up evaluation of graduates in the workplace.
