- II. **New Members:** Keith extended a welcome to the two new members of the PEAB: Jessica Harrison and Amanda Simmons.
- III. **Certification:** Keith indicated that he is getting many calls and questions from school psychologists in the field regarding certification. OSPI will not renew Initial Certifications anymore so many school psychologists are attempting to obtain their Continuing or Residency certificates before their initials expire. He feels that there may be as many as 40 candidates here today for the orientation.
- IV. **PEAB Professional Certification:** Keith feels that to adapt to the new system may require a cadre of reviewers in addition to the current PEAB members. An idea might be to recruit and train these reviewers at a WSASP Conference. Gene indicates that a proposal will need to be presented to the state board in mid November. Therefore, the PEAB will need to meet prior to this to put the proposal together. The meeting was set for October 24, 2008, 9:30 at Franklin Pierce District Office.
