

MINUTES FOR PEAB
December 4, 2001

- I. The minutes for October 23, 2001 were approved “as corrected”.
- II. Reports:
 - A. Jim’s brief on NCATE: CWU is fully accredited with no weakness and is back on the five-year cycle. The committee members understand that Diversity is still an issue. A recommendation was made that the NCATE letter be placed in the PEAB notebook.
 - B. Professional Certificate members read the proposal and made several editing recommendations. These will be addressed in a separate document. The committee asked that the Professional Certificate Proposal be sent for a final review via a hard copy with an email approval before the next meeting.
 - C. Alternative Certification, Jim stated that the only partner is Wenatchee. Osman discussed CTL/CNS plan to meet Alternative Certification needs using route III.
- III. PEAB Mission focus:
 - A. Field Experience Component of Program Design. (PEAB WAC): The committee discussed this section and it was determined it would be helpful if a presentation be provided relative to Professional Sequence and Field Experience, which includes: Course Syllabi’s, Student Teacher Handbook, Pre-Autumn and Data regarding Diversity. The information will be presented at the March meeting, by Osman with the assistance from David.
 - B. “Field experience with ethnic, racial culture population, and with special education and highly capable: “The committee asked that this statement be changed to match the WAC 180-78A 264#6 which is: “field experiences are integrated throughout the preparation program and include experience with diverse populations in a variety of settings.”
