I. Adoption of minutes from 11 March 04: Approved as written

II. Approval of the Agenda: Approved

III. Reports:

- David Shorr announced that C & S and TEP were combined into one department effective 1 July 04. David will remain as chair and Connie Lambert is co-chair through the summer and then there will be a placement of a 2 year co-chair.
- Pedagogy Assessment Instrument is still a pilot. There have been revisions in the instrument and the new revised edition will be out this summer and tested for one year. It will not be mandated for certification until Fall 2005.
- Professional Certificate Report (attachment #1) there are currently 84 candidates in the program. This is the first summer that the culminating seminar is being given.
- First/Third Year Teacher Survey (attachment #2) this is the first year the surveys were on-line and the return rate was almost nine percent. Classroom management and assessment have the lowest ratings. David may suggest for the spring (2005) Speaker Series an invitation be extended for speaker that can address classroom management.
- NCATE/OSPI site visit will be in spring 2006. There was a request for an extension for the visit but OSPI will not because that is the end of the five years for Professional Cert and they do not want to do two separate visits one year apart.
- WA Award of Excellence in Teaching has not been awarded at this time. OSPI has condensed the information needed to be submitted for the award and is now an easier process.

IV. PEAB Mission-Review

- WAC #5-Knowledge & Skills (October 2003)
The committee reviewed during the 2003-04 year the endorsement (30+) areas re-approved by OSPI and there were many discussions regarding the WEST –B and WEST test and timelines.
- Curriculum materials and media collections (ETC) 5 Year Review was accomplished by touring the Educational Technology Center in Black Hall and recommendations to expand and update their materials.

- This year in May the committee chose the top-ten from a field of 42 nominees. With the implementation a new nomination process and much effort by the Certification Office this year's nominations numbers were the highest in several years. There will be an awards presentation and reception later today for the top-ten student and their guests.

V. Recommendation for 2004-2005 Academic Year

- The committee will review Program Approval Standards for Approved Preparation Programs #1, PEAB and #4, Program design. They will also review under the three year review will be policies used to develop agreements for field experiences.
