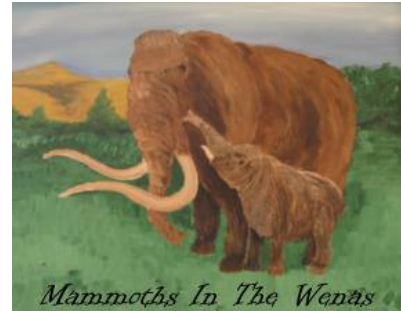


Scholarships for 2008 Wenas Creek Mammoth Field School Central Washington University

For the second year, scholarships are available for students who intend to participate in the summer field school excavating the Wenas Creek mammoth. For 2008, two scholarships of \$500 each will be awarded to the recipients. Each of these awards will apply toward the costs of the \$1,980 tuition.



Eligibility:

All applicants to the Wenas Creek Mammoth Field School are eligible to apply.

Evaluation of applications will take into account four criteria:

- 1) Academic record (GPA and appropriate coursework; 10 points)
- 2) Application statement (10 points)
- 3) Letter of recommendation (10 points)
- 4) Financial need (10 points)

Detailed descriptions of these criteria are found on the application form.

To Apply:

- 1) Apply for summer field school admission, if you have not already done so. Obtain the field school application form (see below) and submit to Dr. Lubinski.
- 2) Apply for scholarship. Obtain the scholarship application form (see below) and submit it and accompanying materials to Dr. Lubinski.
