Program

John Harbaugh is professor of trumpet at Central Washington University. He has over 20 years of college teaching experience. As a jazz educator, bands under his direction have performed at the Montreaux, North Sea and Notre Dame jazz festivals. His trumpet students have consistently been in the semi-final rounds of the National Trumpet Competition in both the undergraduate and graduate divisions. In 2002 his trumpet ensemble placed third at that event. In 2004, the CWU Trumpet Ensemble was invited to perform at the International Trumpet Guild Convention in Denver, CO. His professional experience includes touring with Tom Jones, Paul Anka, and Buddy Rich. He appears on three Grammy-nominated albums and has recorded as a jazz soloist with the London Symphony. He is principal trumpet in the Yakima Symphony Orchestra, and is currently a board member of the National Trumpet Competition and a clinician for C.G. Conn/Selmer Corporation.

Nich Sutherland is a music educator in the state of Washington. He graduated from Central Washington University in 2005 with a bachelor's degree in Instrumental Music Education. During his time as an undergraduate student at CWU, Nich was senator—then president—of Trumpet Club, a competitor in the 2003 National Trumpet Competition trumpet ensemble division, a performer at the 2004 International Trumpet Guild conference, and again a competitor in the 2005 NTC for both the ensemble and solo divisions. After graduation Nich taught at Chiefess Kamakahalei Middle School on the island of Kauai in the state of Hawaii during the 2005-2006 school year. During that time he actively participated in local community college ensembles and played professional gigs all over the island. He also took his middle school jazz and wind bands to the Oahu Band Directors Association music festival. After completing his first year of teaching, Nich returned to CWU, where he is currently a Graduate Teaching Assistant pursuing a master's degree in Music Education with a specialization in Trumpet Performance. He will also be competing at this year's NTC in the Master's Solo Division on March 14th-18th.
