CWU (Central) field trip—World Languages Day, May 8th

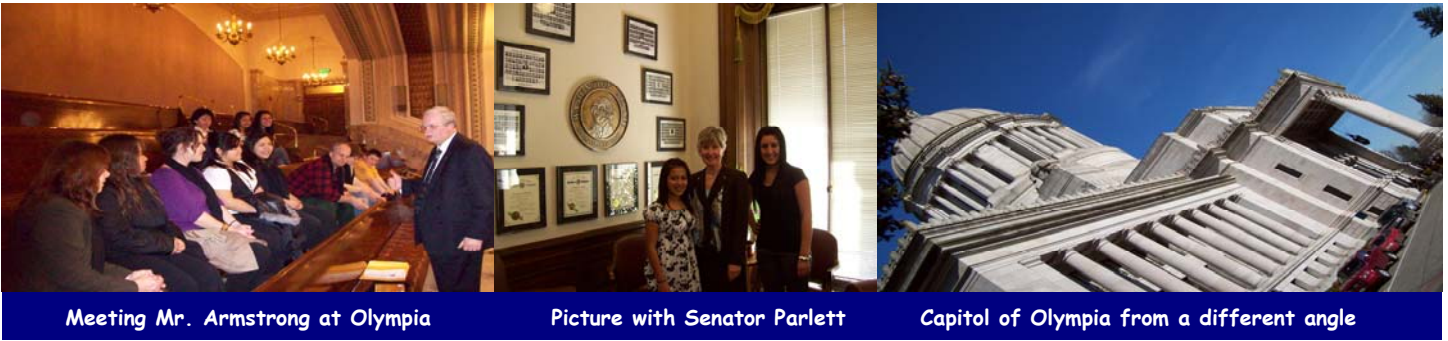
Students will attend 4 presentations of multiple cultures. Pick from over 10 presentations.

The Gear-Up program for Chelan is taking the 8th grade students to the BBCC for a Career Fair.

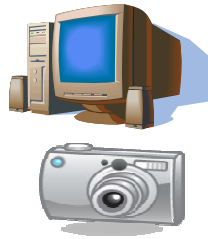
The students will be divided up in groups with similar interests in the Careers they would like to pursue in college.

Computer Training & Digital Photo class

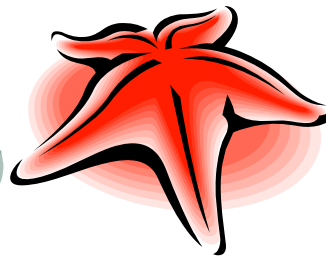
May 16th
