DISTINGUISHED SERVICE RECOGNITION - CIVIL SERVICE AND EXEMPT EMPLOYEES

(1) Eligibility - Distinguished Civil Service Employee and Distinguished Exempt Employee status may be awarded by the board of trustees at the recommendation of the appointing authority upon the retirement or death of civil service and exempt staff after ten years of full-time equivalent employment with the university. The ten-year service requirement may be fulfilled by noncontiguous periods of employment.

(2) Rights and Privileges - Civil Service and exempt staff awarded distinguished service status shall be entitled to:

1. Full library privileges;
2. Campus parking privileges;
3. University identification card bearing name, title during employment with the university, and honorary title;
4. University email account;
5. Receive selected university publications without charge;
6. Participation in the academic and social functions of the university.
