HONORARY DEGREE POLICY

Consistent with RCW 28B.35.205, the Board of Trustees may, upon the recommendation of the faculty, confer honorary bachelor's or master's degrees to individuals who have distinguished themselves by providing extended unusual service to the university, state, or nation, or who are recognized for unusual feats in service to humankind. Typically, recipients of honorary degrees will have close connections to Central Washington University, either as graduates of the institution or as citizens who have rendered significant service to the institution. Individuals of national or international prominence may be recognized if they also have connections to the state of Washington or Central Washington University. Procedures, criteria, and application forms can be found in the Central Washington University Procedures Manual, Section 1-60-020.1.
