Program Description

Explore Chinese culture and language at the Ocean University of China (OUC), located in the beautiful seaside resort city of Qingdao (literal translation: "lush island"; pop. approximately 2.5 million). Qingdao is considered one of China's most beautiful cities and top summer destinations with its long sandy beaches, mild year-round climate, and lush rolling hills. The area's mild summer weather coupled with its standard Mandarin makes Qingdao an ideal place to pursue the study of Chinese language and culture.

During your four weeks in China, you'll be fully immersed in the language and culture through academic study, excursions, and daily life in a Chinese city. All students will take two classes: a Chinese language and a Chinese culture class. This program is open to students at all levels of Chinese, and no prior study of the language is required.
