Champagne & Burgundy, France

Program Description

This program will provide Global Wine Studies students with a unique view of the famous French wine regions of Champagne and Burgundy. Students will have the opportunity to taste some of the best wines in the world and sample traditional meals and local specialties of each region.

In Reims, the capital city of the Champagne region, the group will visit major Champagne houses, intimate boutique wineries, and tour the many vineyards. Students will also learn about the trade structures, successes, and challenges of the region.

Burgundy is the home of small estates with fantastic Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Here students will learn about the *Burgundian* style of winemaking, visit ancient vineyards, and speak with *negociants* about the market for Burgundy wine.

In addition to visiting Champagne and Burgundy, the group will also have a few days to explore Paris.

The Champagne and Burgundy program satisfies the requirement for GWS492 Field Experience for the Global Wine Studies.
