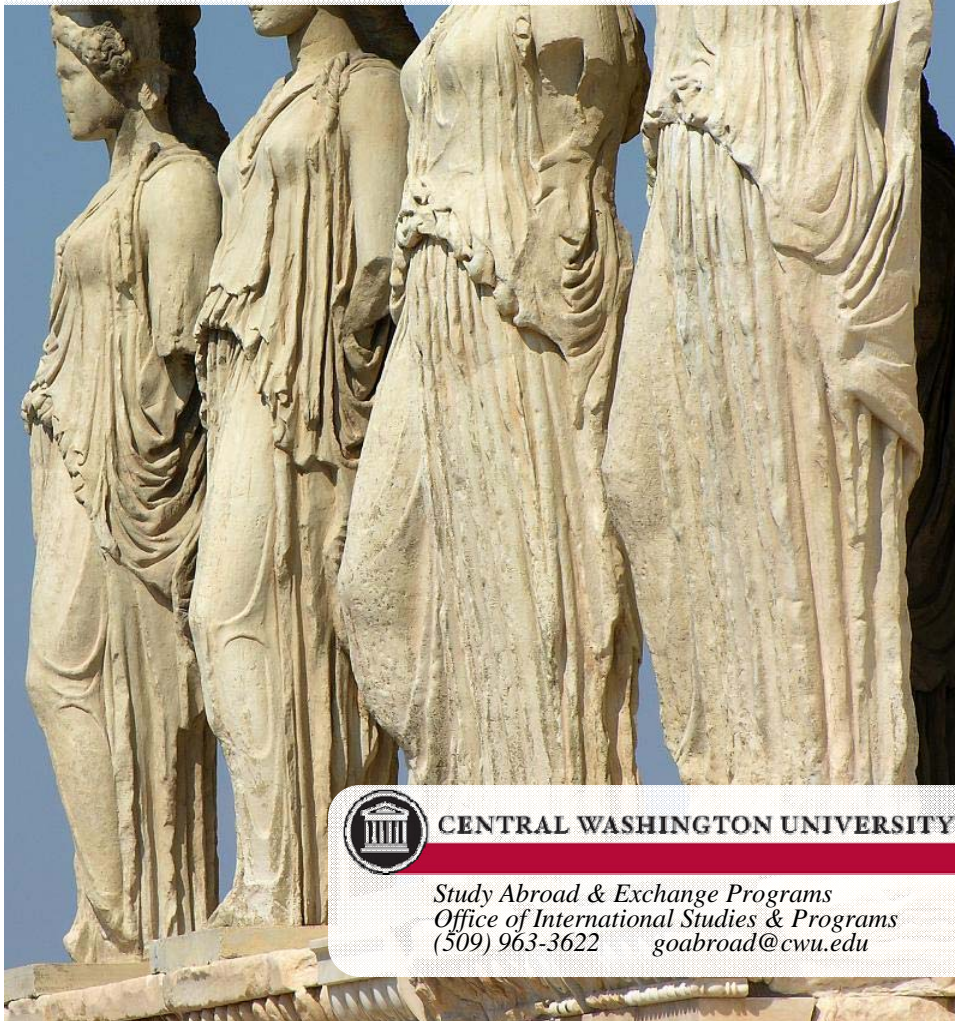

## Athens, Greece

Post Winter Quarter - March 18-29, 2010  
Application Deadline - November 23, 2009

### Program Description

The *Classical Greek Literature and Philosophy* program allows students to experience the unique historical, geographical, and cultural elements of Greece firsthand. Students will travel to the historic areas of Agora and Plaka, under the Acropolis, where Socrates, Plato, and Aristotle walked and taught. The group will read and learn about the works of the famous philosophers and authors of Hellas, stand in the Theater of Epidaurus (a World Heritage Site), and observe the contrasts between the ancient Olympic stadiums and the new.

Classes will be held both on campus throughout winter quarter, and while abroad using lectures and group discussions. Program excursions include: The Parthenon on the Acropolis, the National Museum, the Theater of Epidaurus, the statue of Hermes, the sacred sanctuary of Apollo's oracle, and the Olympic stadiums (ancient and from 2004).
