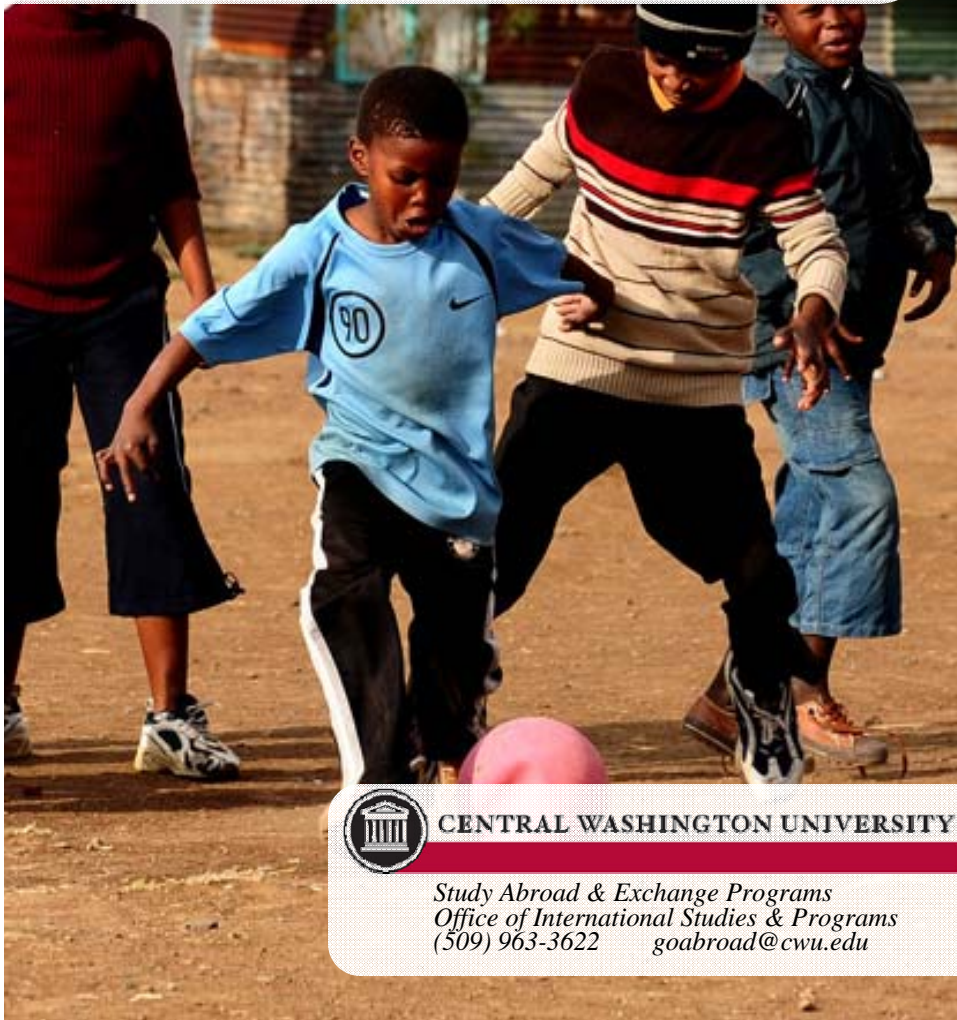

## Johannesburg, South Africa

### Program Description

Dr. Amutabi will lead students through South Africa and assist them in examining at questions of equality in a newly formed (1994) democracy and the history of contemporary South Africa through first hand experiences in and around Johannesburg and Pretoria.

Although South Africa is the wealthiest country in Africa, it still has enormous levels of inequality among its citizens. Formal political equality was achieved in 1994; however, there is still much work to be done. Students will observe this first hand, along with the history of apartheid, as they explore Johannesburg, Pretoria, and surrounding areas. They will also be exposed to current HIV/AIDS issues in these areas and learn about the disease's negative impact on South Africa (where 40% of adults are infected). Program excursions include: Sun City (Africa's Las Vegas), the homes of Nelson Mandela and Desmond Tutu in Soweto, caves in the Gauteng Province, several AIDS centers, and some of the 2010 FIFA facilities.
