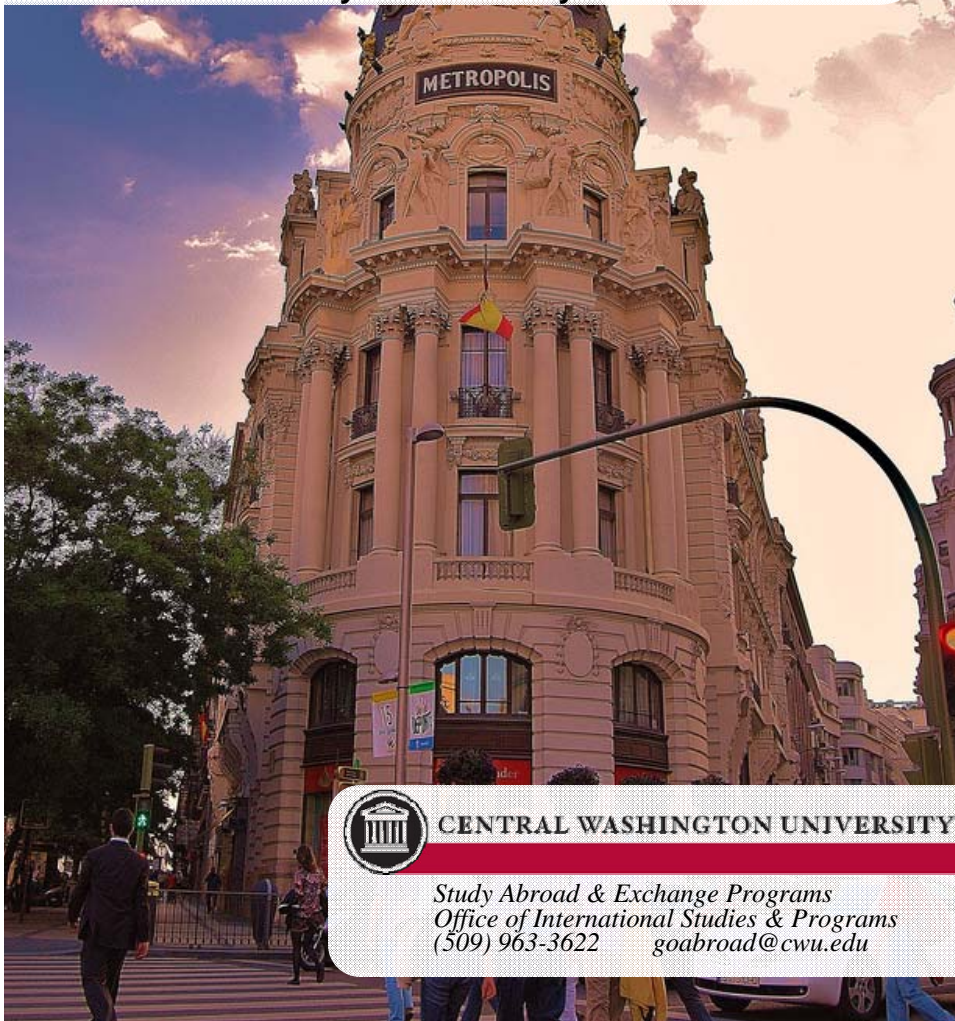

### Program Description

This program aims to introduce communication studies, journalism, public relations, Spanish language, and film/video studies to students who are interested in the field of international communications. Dr. Garcia has arranged for students to meet with guest speakers such as foreign correspondents, politicians, journalists and film directors. They will provide the necessary context to better appreciate Spain and its communication industry.

Spain is the fifth largest European country in terms of economy and population. Its communication landscape is sophisticated, complex and serves as a good representative of Europe, with the largest part of the communication industry located in Madrid. Madrid is surrounded by many historical cities and places that can be visited with one-day trips. Program excursions include: *El Escorial, Segovia, Avila, El Pais or El Mundo newspaper offices, Spanish television offices, meetings with journalists, foreign correspondents, and filmmakers.*
