## A work by three or more authors:

Quirk, Randolph, et al. *A Comprehensive Grammar of the English Language*. London: Longman, 1985.

## A work in an Anthology (essays, stories, articles in textbooks):

McKinstry, Stefan. "No One Here Says What They Mean." *Best New American Voices*. Ed. Richard Bausch. Orlando: Harcourt, 2008. 363-392. Print.

Author. "Title of article, essay, or poem." *Title of Book Being Cited*. Ed. Editor of book (First then last name). City of Publication: Publishing company, Year of Publication. Pages of article, essay, or poem. Medium of Publication.

## An Article/Entry in a Reference Work (Dictionary or Encyclopedia)—With and without authors:

"Hindu Music." *The New Columbia Encyclopedia*. 4th ed. 1975. Print.

Le Patourel, John. "Normans and Normandy." *Dictionary of the Middle Ages*. Ed. Joseph R. Strayer. 2<sup>nd</sup> ed. Vol. 8. New York: Scribner, 1987. Print.

Author (if available). "Article/Entry Title." *The Complete Book Title*. Editor(s) information. Number of Volumes (if more than one). City of Publication, Year of Publication. Medium of Publication.

## Article from an Academic Journal in a database:

Mann, Susan. "Myths of Asian Womanhood." *Journal of Asian Studies* 59 (2000): 205-15. Web. *JSTOR*. 27 July 09.

Author. "Title of Article." *Full Title of Journal* volume number (year): page numbers of article. City of Publication. *Access Information*. Access Date (if electronic).

## Literary or Scholarly Edition of a Text:

Twain, Mark. *The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn*. Ed. Guy Cardell. New York: Penguin Classics, 2002. Print.

Author. Title of Edition. Editor(s) information ("gen. ed." is general editor/ Ed. is "Edited by"). City of Publication: Publisher, Year of Publication. Medium of Publication.
