

Dear Colleagues,

Thank you for your participation in Phase I of the Strategic Planning process. We had 62 groups take part, with a total of 733 participants (310 faculty, 376 staff, 22 administrators, and 25 students). The Steering Committee has collated the results of Phase I in preparation for our work together on Friday for Phase II, which will focus on our Values. The results from Phase I will be posted on the <u>Updates</u> website this week, along with details about the Phase II activity.

In addition, we have expanded options for watching the State of the University address and for participating in Phase II of the process.
