• Multiple yearly exhibits on topics of environmental and cultural interest, with input and installation assistance from CWU students.

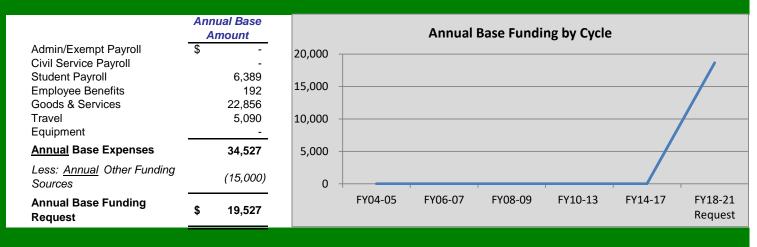
• Special lectures for students and the public by visiting professionals in association with current exhibit topics.

• 4,400 visits were made to the gallery in 2015-2016, including 1400 Pre-K to Grade 12 students. Museum Studies students led and participated in many of the K-12 tours.
