#### **Old Business:**

### **A.** Supplemental Funding Requests – Voting:

i. #1819 AMA International Collegiate Conference (Marketing Association) -\$18,731.14

Discussion: Why did the club choose the 18 students? What happened to the point system? In planning this trip we wanted to make it open to all that were interested, if we do not receive enough funding we will use the point system to narrow down the number that will be

going. The College of Business is fronting the funding so that the students do not have to pay out of pocket and be reimbursed.

MOTION: Alex Horning made a motion to approve Supplemental Funding Request #1819 in the amount of \$14,000.00. Shelby Hamblen seconded. Motion carried as amended.

### A. Supplemental Funding Requests – Presentation

# i. #1822 – Phi Alpha Theta Regional Conference (History Club) - \$4,197.00

The group would like to take up to 24 students to the regional conference in Spokane April 20-21, 2018. They will be presenting, networking, and making connections for Master's Programs. CWU students have won awards at this conference in past years. Call for papers just went out so they will find out which presentations are accepted and may change the number of students travelling.

# B. Decoupling S&A from Tuition

Discussion: The S&A Fee and Tuition have historically been coupled together, meaning that if Tuition was increased or decreased the S&A Fee could be increased or decreased only by the same percentage. If Decoupled S&A and Tuition would not be tied together and each could be increased or decreased as needed. The committee would support decoupling, Alex will draft a letter of support and bring to the next meeting for review / approval.
