A new staff member was hired to manage Campus Activities with a start date of Sept. 16, 2023. Fall program planning was conducted by a temp employee over the summer, in consultation with the director of SLICE.

2. Please provide an overview of the student-centered programming provided, i.e. type of programs, milestones, number of students impacted, and how they benefited.

Campus Activities provided a wide range of social, cultural, and co-curricular programming designed to enhance student connections, sense of belonging, and opportunities open to all students. These programs offered accessibility and ways for students to engage at different levels; they could sit back and enjoy as an audience member or get immersed in more interactive events. Traditional programming included movies, open mic and game nights, live music, and social/mixer events. On a larger scale, Campus Activities provided entertainment and coordination for events at Week of Welcome, Homecoming, Family Weekend, and Student Appreciation Day. This year we also provided support for a number of multicultural student signature events.

There were some transitional challenges with a professional staff vacancy over the summer, and an all-new staff (student and professional) starting Sept. 16, 2023. This team hit the ground running and saw high event attendance numbers during Week of Welcome (ranging from 100-500 per event) and throughout most of fall quarter.

The number of Campus Activities sponsored/coordinated events dropped in winter and spring quarters, but involvement in collaborations and support of a number of student org events increased. Attendance data wasn't consistently captured due to connectivity issues with the Presence software.

Overall, Campus Activities coordinated or provided significant support for 100+ events: 43 in Fall quarter, 35 in Winter, and 36 in Spring. These included weekly movies, open mic and game nights, a winter dance, comedy shows, Homecoming entertainment and activities, Halloween events, student org signature event support (MEChA, FASA, PISA),

ASCWU and Student Appreciation events, Dive-In movies with Recreation, and numerous collaborations with other units in Student Leadership, Involvement and Community Engagement (SLICE.)
