Policy

(1) Purpose

- A. This policy governs the use of electric vehicle charging stations (EVCSs) that are in parking lots which are owned and/or operated by Central Washington University (CWU). All EVCSs will be clearly marked by signage and green pavement markings as required by RCW 46.08.185.

(2) General Rules

- A. Vehicles parked in an EVCS must be in compliance with all other parking rules for that parking area as described in chapter 106.116 WAC.
- B. Vehicles must be actively charging while parked in an EVCS. Per RCW 46.08.185, a monetary penalty will be assessed to any vehicle parked in an EVCS on public or private property if the vehicle is not connected to the charging equipment.
- C. There is no additional charge to plug into an EVCS.
- D. Must have a valid CWU parking permit.

(3) Restrictions

- A. Charging of an electric vehicle is limited to an EVCS only.
- B. EVCSs may be closed for special event parking, maintenance, and/or construction.
- C. An EVCS may be reserved through the Parking Services office for special event parking.
- D. CWU assumes no responsibility or liability for damage to vehicles using an EVCS.
- E. No person may use non-EVCS electrical outlets of any facility owned and/or operated by CWU for vehicle charging except for vehicles that are owned or leased by CWU.
- F. A violation of these rules may result in issuance of a parking infraction.
