**Draft SES Vision:**

The Division of Student Engagement and Success will facilitate access, community, and belonging throughout all phases of the student experience.

**Written feedback from Fall '22 SES Retreat (11/8/22) in response to how the draft SES Vision aligns (or doesn't) with CWU's Vision and what's missing:**

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Repeating community/belonging</li> <li>❖ Aligns well &amp; uses same wording</li> <li>❖ Aligned well utilizing similar words "community" and "belonging"</li> <li>❖ Aligns well</li> <li>❖ Sense of community &amp; belonging</li> <li>❖ SES provides students with the individual experiences within, such as access, community &amp; belonging</li> <li>❖ Likes "all phases"</li> <li>❖ Community/belonging</li> <li>❖ Belonging &amp; Access</li> <li>❖ Community, belonging, access – category words are good, supporting overall student experience.</li> <li>❖ Sounds like it's "on the road" to the CWU vision (we're the hub)</li> <li>❖ Similar but needs some work</li> <li>❖ Both include "will", access &amp; equity</li> <li>❖ Very similar; content is similar</li> <li>❖ Most specific SES aspects seem to fit nicely to the larger CWU mission</li> <li>❖ Yes by intention, not by action</li> <li>❖ Very similar in intent</li> <li>❖ Sense of community &amp; belonging, barrier removal for students.</li> <li>❖ Yes, mirrors the language, minus "equity"</li> <li>❖ Both focus on belonging, access, equity, and support the (?)</li> <li>❖ Both discuss belonging</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Doesn't touch on model/learning piece. What is SES's "Why"? Environmental stewardship/longevity of university, human capital/employee side</li> <li>▪ Equity is missing</li> <li>▪ Equity is missing in SES version</li> <li>▪ Equity (repeated through multiple feedback notes)</li> <li>▪ Watch student from start to finish – including grad students. Model learning community = growing &amp; learning.</li> <li>▪ Group doesn't think anything's missing/bad</li> <li>▪ Education/learning component is missing</li> <li>▪ "Throughout all phases" – maybe too limited?</li> <li>▪ Add "equitable" before "access"</li> <li>▪ Feels less aspirational than overall vision</li> <li>▪ Needs stronger action word than "facilitating"</li> <li>▪ Learning element is missing – we teach students through our services</li> <li>▪ It's utilitarian, not as aspirational</li> <li>▪ Change "facilitate" maybe to "support" (gives control to students)? "Cultivate", "Promote", "Elevate"?</li> <li>▪ The verbiage could be more clear – change "facilitate" to "elevate" or "foster"</li> <li>▪ Replace "facilitate" with "Promote", "Support", "Cultivate", "Elevate", "Foster"</li> <li>▪ Change "seamless pipeline" to "central portal"</li> <li>▪ Revisit the word "facilitate" – maybe cultivate/foster/nurture</li> <li>▪ "All phases" – what do the phases entail?</li> <li>▪ Doesn't explicitly include "equity", just access which is related</li> <li>▪ Define "Access" – for entering and remaining at CWU? Minimizing equity as a core aspect to vision statement</li> <li>▪ Departments don't work together – more collaborative mindset to give a more collaborative experience to students</li> <li>▪ Potentially missing educational experience</li> <li>▪ Outreach, collaboration through all phases, support &amp; resources</li> <li>▪ Students should be aware of the services.</li> <li>▪ Suggested: "The Division of SES will facilitate access, equity and support throughout all phases of the student experience"</li> <li>▪ Does not discuss equity component</li> </ul>

**Written feedback from Fall '22 SES Retreat (11/8/22) in response to how the draft SES Mission aligns (or doesn't) with CWU's Mission and what's missing:**

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Equity, access &amp; success overlap</li> <li>❖ "Seamless Pipeline" = relationship building</li> <li>❖ Supports CWU mission by focusing on the student experience, emphasis on access</li> <li>❖ Student successes</li> <li>❖ Expanding access &amp; success</li> <li>❖ They relate nicely – verbiage confusing to students?</li> <li>❖ Less aligned than the visions but like that it is succinct.</li> <li>❖ Both emphasize equity and success.</li> <li>❖ Equity → equitable access</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Verbiage aligning with why students are really here (degree/job success) experience, needs less transactional language, more emphasis on degree/job success.</li> <li>▪ No references to high-impact practices, evidence-based, community partnerships</li> <li>▪ Equity is missing; replace word "fosters" with "provides" or "builds"</li> <li>▪ Need words that reflect, strives for &amp; work toward vs. foster an equitable &amp; seamless pipeline. We need to partner internally and across campus. Missing support aspect – academics, physical &amp; mental</li> <li>▪ Each student experience is unique and "pipeline" isn't the correct word</li> <li>▪ No to "pipeline" and "attainment"</li> <li>▪ Sustainability of people &amp; resources</li> <li>▪ Doesn't like "attainment of educational aspirations"</li> <li>▪ Should emphasize life skills vs. degree focus – help students to be productive citizens in the community</li> <li>▪ SES Mission is missing operationalization that CWU Mission has – consider "innovative practices, adapting to needs of changing generation"</li> <li>▪ Needs elements of collaboration and synergy between departments</li> <li>▪ It sounds like a vision statement, needs more specifics – how are we being equitable? Collaborative?</li> <li>▪ The word "Seamless" is an aspirational word/concept, not realistic.</li> <li>▪ Wording doesn't emphasize support, should include support &amp; resources, collaboration: "Outreach, collaboration, support &amp; resources throughout all phases of the student experience</li> <li>▪ Problematic, too general, see proposed replacement "SES Mission Statement" (notes)</li> <li>▪ Don't use "pipeline"- replace with "journey" / replace with "guided process" / "guided pathway"</li> <li>▪ Is pipeline the right word? SES is no longer transactional and is more immersive.</li> <li>▪ Does not address community partnerships &amp; meaningful relationships</li> <li>▪ How to give equitable access (see notes below)</li> <li>▪ "Pipeline" language isn't incredibly specific and too transactional, needs to have more actionable and measurable language. For example: "The division of SES provides &amp; engages in equitable and culturally informed policies, practices, services and co-curricular experiences that support student success throughout their journey.</li> <li>▪ We can't guarantee "seamless" but can suggest "integrated"</li> <li>▪ Swap "aspirations" for "experiences"</li> <li>▪ "Seamless pipeline" seems like a guarantee and tells students it will be easy – change to support network or channel</li> <li>▪ Suggested: "The Division of SES fosters an equitable and supportive experience through access and success during the student journey"</li> </ul>

## Notes & Key Points (Additional 11/8/22 written feedback on draft SES Vision and Mission Statements):

- Maybe more emphasis on entire CWU community of students, employees, alum, as a whole.
- Suggest removing transactional language: “pipeline”, “seamless”, “fostering”
- Should have more references to equity, community partnerships/building
- To be a model learning community, we facilitate connection by educating students on where and how they belong.
- SES helps students be successful by reducing barriers, increasing access to resources, improving communication & increasing partnerships across campus.
- We as a division need to work together to support our incoming, transfer, international, center, current & graduate students.
- (Multiple single-word notes): “Trending”
- We are all educators, but some of our focuses are outside of classroom learning – this may be dependent on finalized division structure
- Refocus and include reference to helping students gain resilience – ultimately their feelings of belonging, etc. includes personal responsibility, especially once they leave CWU.
- Many units go beyond students. “Building a foundation to support students in their success”
- Alt SES Vision: “SES will be a portal & central guide to the CWU experience and a catalyst for community building”
- Vision Edits: Change “facilitate” (transactional) to more relational language. Insert “equitable” before “access”. Replace “all phases of the” and replace with “the CWU” before “student experience.
- Alt SES Mission: “SES provides an equitable and personalized experience of student access and success throughout their journey, including building a foundation for lifelong success.” Also reference to “innovative practices” and “adapting to needs of a changing generation”
- “Pipeline” reminds me of “school-to-prison pipeline”. Path? Trail? Something more organic & lists an end goal. Needs warmer language.
- Processing (Operations) team isn’t reflected within these statements
- Found the missions and visions relate well but the verbiage could be improved upon for SES – replace “facilitate” and “pipeline”
- **Proposed replacement for SES Mission: *In order to be a community of equity and belonging, the Division of SES provides intentional, student-centered programs, processes and tools for student access and success throughout their journey.***
- We need to acknowledge departments that are struggling to stay afloat prior to moving forward to best meet students’ needs.
- Like the shared replacement “in order to provide access, community & belonging, SES ...”
- Our work needs to remain consistent throughout the entire academic career. We strive to empower not good employees but good citizens.
- Why not copy wholesale vs. duplicate light?
- For our area, we are committed to developing partnerships with the community and establishing meaningful relationships, which we’d like to see addressed in mission/vision.
- Equity is great, liberation is better. SES vision should focus on students thriving.
- A seamless pipeline is not attainable; better to have more realism than idealism. Something more about “guiding”. We really want to focus on social justice and liberation.
- How to give equitable access: i.e. language (not providing equitable language access) / Financial Aid website – Spanish version last updated 2016 (especially when trying to promote CWU as Spanish-serving university) / Building access to handicap-accessible restrooms.
- Services – some areas seem focused on education until they graduate, missing the focus on what happens after graduation (how education transfers into a career)
- Collaboration between departments to provide an equitable and successful student experience, and how educational path can translate into a career.
- Support students throughout/alongside academic experiences
- Our work in SES goes beyond “educational aspirations” – this draft doesn’t include the tangible skills students have after their experience
- Outreach, collaboration, supports, resources within SES and other departments & academic supports, collaboration
- Inclusion of other departments (academics) in addition to “within SES”
