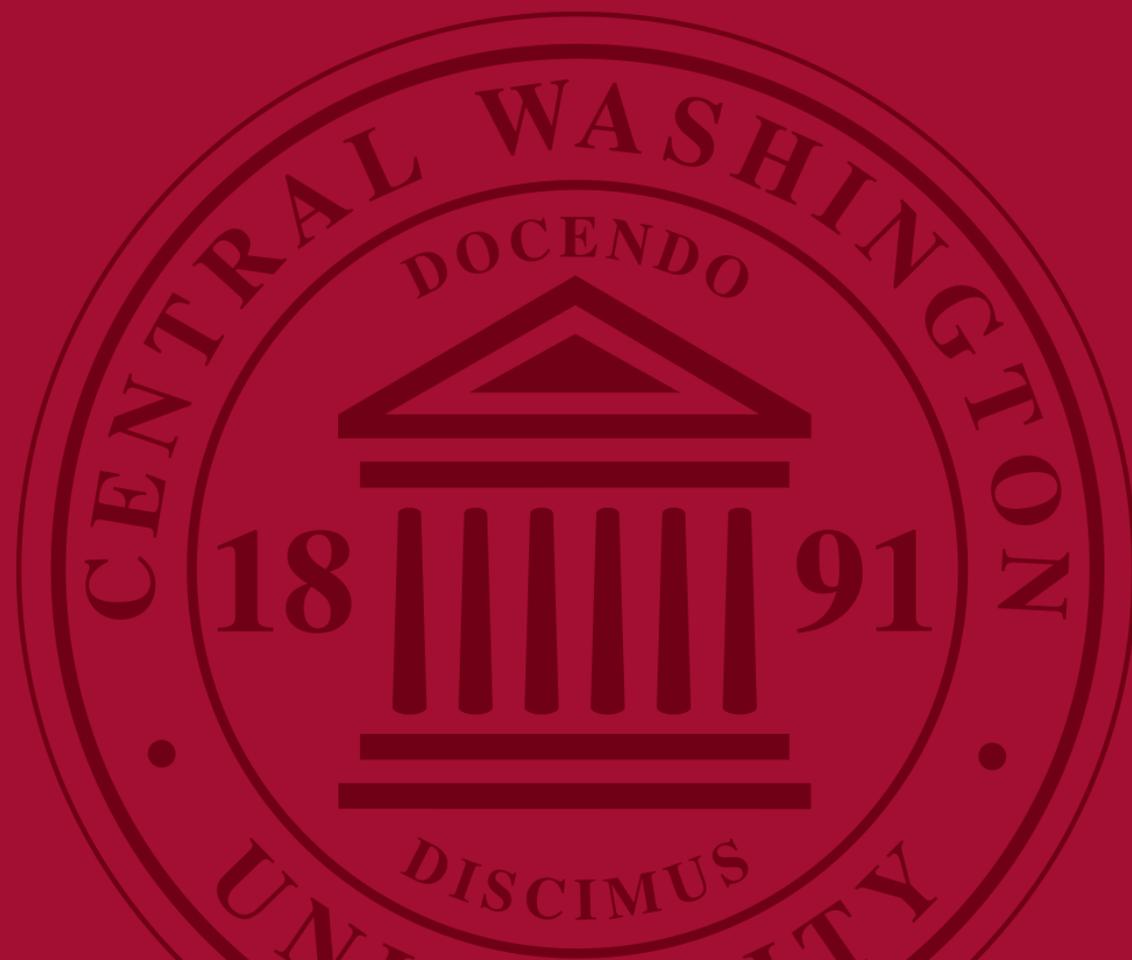

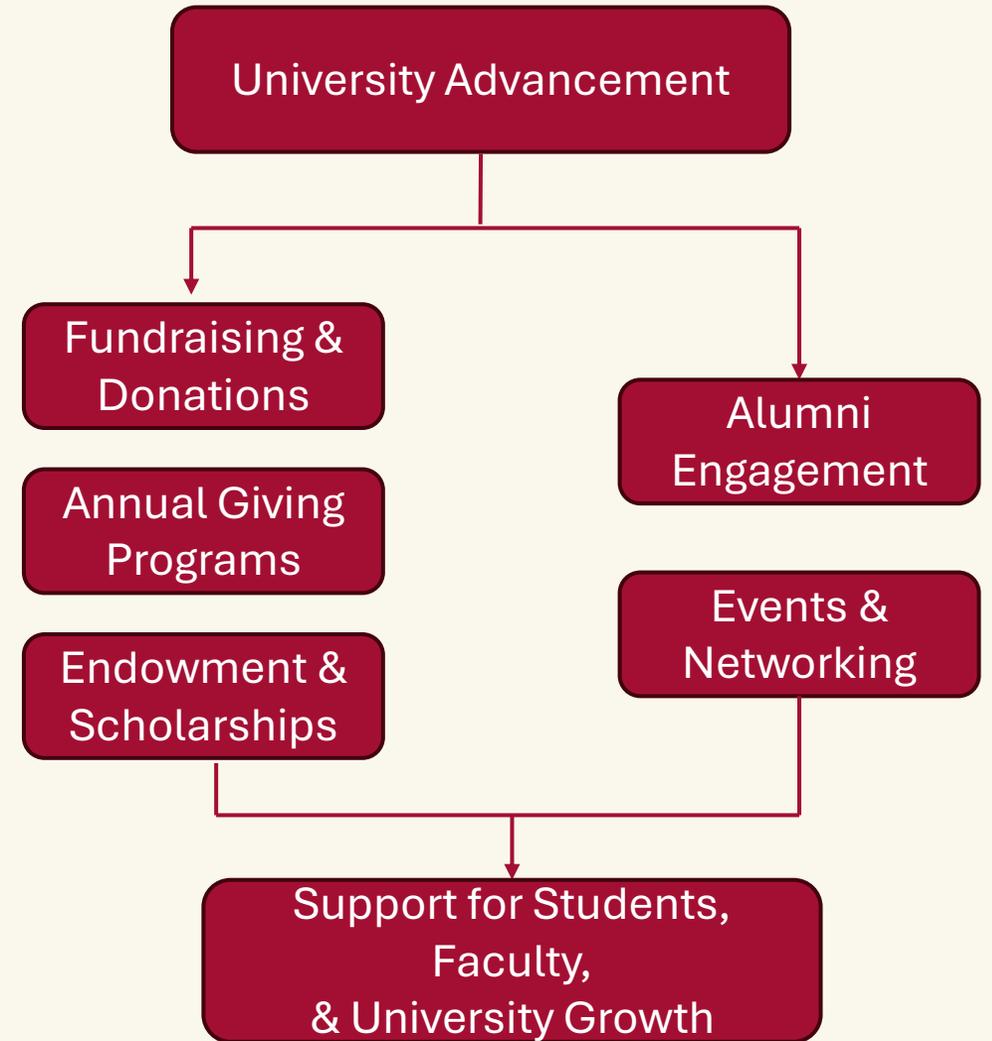

The Office of University Advancement at Central Washington University fosters enduring relationships and mobilizes generosity to support the University's vision by developing pathways to authentic engagement with alumni, donors, and friends.



HOW DOES #GIVECENTRAL SUPPORT THE STRATEGIC PLAN?

Goal 1: Equitable access, student engagement, success

Develop clear pathways into and through the university to ensure equitable access to higher education, enhance student engagement and success, and improve retention and graduation rates.

#GiveCentral funds high-impact practices that improve retention & student success while creating opportunities through authentic engagement.

WHAT IS #GIVECENTRAL?

Annual university-wide 24-hour giving day and event in the Spring

- Engages approximately 52,000 people
- Multi-channel and in-person

Historical Context

- Before #GiveCentral, donations came through Giving Societies, special campaigns, and community events
- First day of giving launched in 2016 as *Giving Tuesday*
- Became the CWU Annual Giving Day in 2017, now known as *#GiveCentral*

Impact (FY25)

- Raised \$100,000+
- From 422 donors (105% of donor goal)
- 36 Projects | 9 Challenge Gifts

HOW #GIVECENTRAL WORKS

**#GiveCentral relies on crowdfunding.
But what is crowdfunding?**

- It is a focused, time-limited fundraising approach
- It is designed to raise money through many small gifts, often online
- Successful projects have clear scope & funding goals (e.g., instruments, food, equipment, travel support)
- Time-limited campaigns create excitement and urgency

Focused:

- Clear goal & funding target

Tangible:

- Donors see exactly what their gift does

Inspiring:

Time-Sensitive:

- Creates urgency & excitement

CREATE YOUR OWN PROJECT

Step 1: Establish your project

Define your idea in one or two sentences. This should sound like an aspirational goal.

Step 2: ID your funding target

This should clearly state the amount you wish to raise and provide the donor with an idea of how their donation will be utilized.

Step 3: Write a short narrative

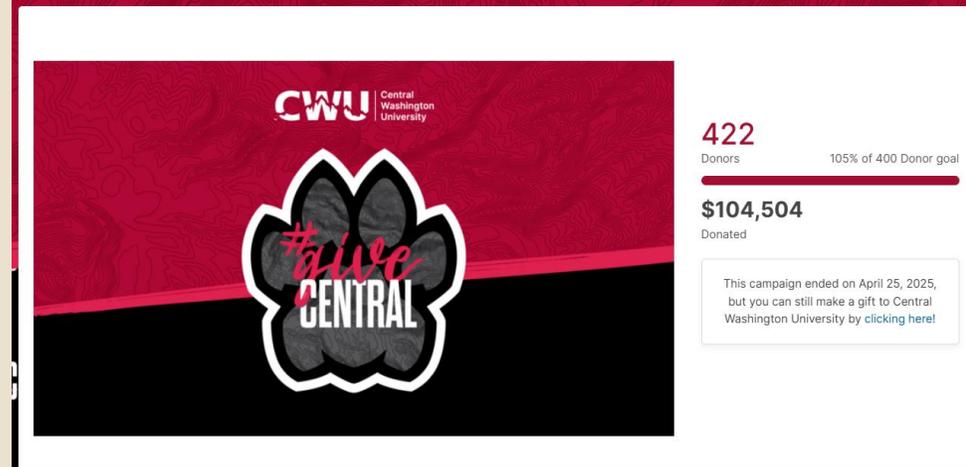
Write 2-3 sentences that tell the story of your project. This is your case for support.

Step 4: Create an advocacy plan

Briefly outline how you and your team will spread the word and engage your community on #GiveCentral.

Step 5: Wrap Up & Thank Donors

Plan your thank you. Is it a card? An email?

Step 4: Create an advocacy plan

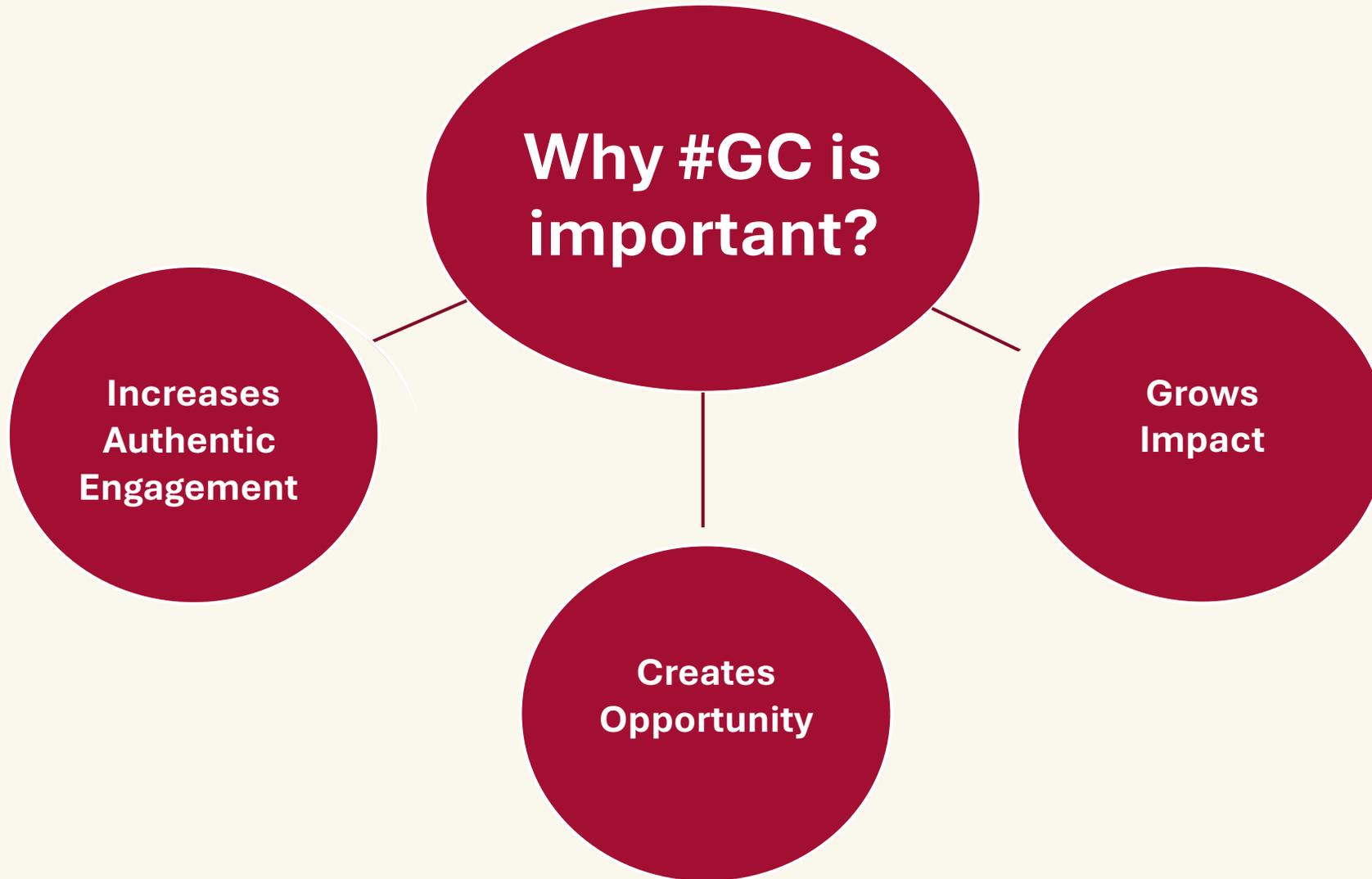
Step 5: Wrap Up & Thank Donors
