Specific



Answer the 5W's:

- Who's involved?

Measurable



 What form of measurement are you going to use to determine if you've met the goal?

Achievable



 The goal is meant to inspire motivation. Think about how to accomplish the goal and if you have the tools/skills needed.

Relevant



 The goal needs to align with your subject objective.

Time-Based



 Ask specific questions about the goal deadline and what can be accomplished within that time period.
