# Spring 2024 Start of Quarter Procedures for Canvas Course Management

### **Canvas Updates**

Spring Courses Available Wednesday, February 27th, 2024

<u>Multi-select Gradebook Filters</u> - In the Gradebook, instructors can choose multiple filter options for each filter type. This update improves the user experience by streamlining the process of managing filter selections, offering increased customization options, and facilitating faster filter navigation.

<u>CWU Faculty Artificial Intelligence (AI) Resources</u> - This module (requires CWU login) explores AI syllabi statements, student discussion guides, AI literacy, language and policy explorations as well as recordings of all the MML faculty AI conversations.

#### Turnitin has AI Detection accessible in Canvas

Multimodal Learning encourages faculty to have conversations with students about the use of AI in their courses at the beginning of each term and include their policy in the syllabus. Given the possibility of false positives, we recommend that faculty interpret the Turnitin AI report individually and according to course or department policies.

#### New Quizzes and LockDown Browser

New Quizzes and the Lockdown Browser: If you are using the Respondus Lockdown Browser with New Quizzes, please make sure that students first access the quiz from <a href="https://canvas.cwu.edu">https://canvas.cwu.edu</a> in their regular browser. Students will then be prompted to open the quiz with the Lockdown browser. Launching the Lockdown browser and then navigating to the Quiz creates an error with the New Quizzes tool.

Faculty are responsible for publishing their Canvas course. Students cannot view or participate in the course until it is published. Canvas courses should be published by the first day of instruction, March 26, by 8am.

#### Combined Course sections in Canvas

Course sections that share the following criteria will again automatically be combined in Canvas:

- 1. Course ID (Ex: ENG101)
- 2. Instructor of record
- 3. Teaching modality (online / face-to-face / hybrid)

#### Within a combined Canvas course, faculty can still:

- Set differentiated due dates by section
- Filter the gradebook by section
- Send out announcements by section

What if I do not want my course sections combined? If you do not want your course sections combined, complete the <u>Separate Combined Course Sections Request form</u>. Course sections cannot be separated after the term has started or assignment submissions have been made.

Cross-listing Canvas Course Sections: If your course sections are not automatically combined in Canvas but meet the criteria for cross-listing, complete the <u>Canvas Cross-listing Request form.</u>
