Call to order

1891 Bistro project

Jim Matheny and Joseph Pearson talked to the council about the Memo of Understanding between University Catering and the Student Tech Fee Council regarding the bistro project. Jim Matheny presented Fall Quarter sales based on the new late hours in the Bistro, according to Jim the new hours have shown to be successful, however there were decreases in sales from 3am to 6am. Joseph explained what the memo indicated and expressed the importance of figuring out hours and employee rates for Winter quarter 2019 by December 14, 2018. Due to lack of time the council decided to have a meeting the week of finals to discuss the bistro project.

TopHat

Chris Schedler presented on the progress of TopHat, a student engagement app used in classrooms. Currently the STF bought a year license for \$45,000 and it has 2,500 licenses (Tier 1). We are currently using over 2,600 licenses, this is allowed because TopHat wants to see if we need more than 2,500 licenses. If STF decides to pay for another year, CWU would have to move to tier 2 based on its current usage. Tier 2 would cost \$81,000, Tier 3 would cost \$129,000. Chris said he would be back again at the end of winter quarter to give another update.

Funding Requests

There were 7 multimodal funding requests that needed to be voted on but due to lack of time, STF will meet during finals week to vote on the requests.
