

# **EFC 330: Field Experience (2 Credits)**

#### **Description:**

Field Experience students observe, reflect, and potentially assist with instructional and school activities for approximately 60 hours over the quarter. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, these hours and roles are flexible depending upon the capacity of the school and mentor teacher's capacity, and can be completed in a virtual environment.

## **Expectations of partner schools:**

- Invite student to observe classes and professional activities (online or in person); assign independent reading (ex: code of conduct, curriculum materials).
- As capacity permits, provide opportunities for student to participate and assist the mentor teacher. This may include reading to the class, explaining assignments, taking attendance, leading classroom activities, etc.
- Mentor teacher completes an evaluation form.

### **Expectations of Field Experience student:**

- Observe and reflect on instructional and student activities.
- Assist mentor teacher as assigned.
- Complete reflections and record hours in field experience log book provided by CWU.
- Attend seminars hosted by their designated CWU faculty field supervisor.

## **Course objectives:**

- A. Participate in selective instructional and student-related activities and attend professional meetings.
- B. **Observe and note the professional relationships** among administrators, teachers, other certified and non-certified professionals, students, and their parents.
- C. Observe and note the various classroom management procedures used by classroom teachers.
- D. **Observe and describe the different teaching methods** used by classroom teachers, includeing the use of Academic Language and Student Voice (Teacher Performance Assessment).
- E. Observe and record information about the use of Constructivism in PK-12 schools.
- F. **Discuss community resources and services** available to the classroom teacher with your mentor teacher and record the information.
- G. Note experiences through observation and interaction in a PK-12 setting, including curriculum materials.
- H. If schedules permit (optional): Assist in preparing for the new instructional year or the first few days of school.

#### **Supervision:**

CWU field supervisor will conduct observations and/or visits. Partner school personnel should complete the <u>Focus of Concern Form</u> or contact the Coordinator of Field Experiences (<u>Heather.Spalding@cwu.edu</u>) if concerns arise.
