

# GENERAL EQUIPMENT LIST\*

## Geology 188

\*This is a general equipment list to get you thinking about what you might need for a GEOL 188 camping trip. This list is subject to change based on trip location, weather, etc.

### REQUIRED GEAR

- LUNCH x 2** ***YOU MUST PROVIDE YOUR OWN LUNCH***
- Money for snacks, etc.
- Personal Identification
- Boots *Must be broken in*
- Socks *Thick hiking socks*
- Hiking Pants
- Long sleeve shirt/jacket
- Hat *Hats with wide brims all around work best.  
String around chin works well for windy days.*
- Rain Gear
- Warm Coat/wind breaker *CAN BE COLD AT NIGHT: bring layers*
- Sunscreen *if needed*
- Water Bottles *Equivalent of 2 one-quart water bottles*
- Flashlight/Headlamp
- Sleeping Bag
- Tent (can share with friends, rent from OPR)
- Sleeping pad (goes under sleeping bag) **IMPORTANT**
- Anything else you need for the evening
- Sunglasses
- Notebook
- Pencils/Pens
- Backpack *Day pack; we will take several hikes*
- Toiletries, medications, etc.
- Mug
- Personal Silverwear

If you have, bring along:

- Bandanna
- Camera
- Binoculars
- Camp Chair

What the Geology Department will provide:

- Breakfast and dinner food
- Cooking equipment (stove, pots, pans)
- Dishes
- Cleaning materials (dish soap, etc.)
