### History Major (Large Plan – 79 Credits)

*It is recommended that students who plan to enter graduate school complete two years of a world language at the college level.*

#### Required Courses

##### Lower Division Credits: 20

Select 20 credits from the following:

##### **World Civilization**

- \* HIST 101 (5), World History to 1500
- \* HIST 102 (5), World History 1500-1815
- \* HIST 103 (5), World History since 1815

##### **United States History**

- HIST 143 (5), United States History to 1865
- HIST 144 (5), United States History since 1865

##### Upper-Division Credits: 59

- HIST 302 (5), Historical Methods (Students must earn a minimum grade of C as a major requirement)
- HIST 481 (4), Senior Thesis (Students must earn a minimum grade of C as a major requirement)
- Upper-Division United States History (5)
