For NTT faculty assigned to teaching

1. 5 or more years of continued service
2. 113 accumulated workload units of teaching
3. Demonstrated excellence as determined through a substantive review of the faculty member's cumulative performance, including, but not limited to SEOIs and peer evaluations

For NTT faculty assigned to duties in addition to teaching (performance, accompanying, coordination, etc.)

1. Meet or exceed the benchmarks outlined above
2. Demonstrated excellence as determined through a substantive review of the faculty member's cumulative performance in the additional duty/duties

Demonstrated excellence as determined through a substantive review of the faculty member's cumulative performance, as outlined in Appendix A "**Evaluation Policies and Required Documentation for Teaching**" of the Music Faculty Performance Standards, parts I, II and III.
