**PSYCHOLOGY MAJOR, B.A. 60-CREDITS**

Effective: Fall 2015

Students seeking a B.A. degree must complete one year college/university study or two years high school of a single foreign language.

The 60-credit major is intended to provide a foundation for professional careers and/or graduate training in psychology. It requires substantial coursework in the methodological, statistical and content areas of psychology, while still allowing for individualized student interests and choice. Students enrolled in the 60-credit major also have the opportunity to receive credit towards their degree for participation in professional development and research experiences.
