

Funding Opportunities for Graduate Student Research & Creative Activities

School of Graduate Studies and Research (SGSR)

The SGSR offers three funding awards per year:
one in the fall and two in the spring

Research/Creative Activity Support Award

- **Up to \$1,000** (paid by reimbursement)
- **Fall deadline:** November 30, 2025, by 11:59pm
- **Spring deadline:** April 5, 2026, by 11:59pm

Eligible Expenses

- Research or creative activity supplies and equipment
- Nonretroactive travel (to complete project)

Application Materials

- Abstract, project description, project timeline, references, itemized budget (templates provided), CV/resume, appendix (if applicable)

Final Report

- Summarize project results and list any publications that resulted from the award.



Summer Fellowship

- **\$3,500** (paid as federally taxable lump sum)
- **Deadline:** April 5, 2026, by 11:59pm

Eligible Expenses

- Funding may be used at the discretion of the recipient to support research or creative activities that contribute to the completion of the thesis, creative project, or portfolio review

Application Materials

- Abstract, project description, project timeline, references, CV/resume, appendix (if applicable)

Final Report

- Summarize project results and list any publications that resulted from the award.

Applicant Eligibility

- Graduate students must be in good academic standing pursuing a thesis, project, or portfolio review.
- Applicants must have an approved Graduate Committee and Option Approval Form on file with the SGSR.
- Proposal must be endorsed by the graduate committee chair.
- Approval from the Human Subjects Review Council (HSRC) or Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC), if applicable.
