HOW TO ACCESS ETUTORING:

To set up your account:

- Visit the eTutoring login page at www.etutoringonline.org
- Click “Login” on the top right of the screen, select
- Select “Washington” then “Central Washington University” to navigate to the CWU login page
- Select “Student” as User Type
- Click on the “Forgot password?” link under the login boxes
- Then, **enter your CWU email address** to create a password for yourself. Check your email for the password reset link. You must use your CWU email address to reset your password, or the system will not recognize you.

To log in:

- Visit the login page at www.etutoringonline.org
- Select “Washington” then “Central Washington University” to navigate to the CWU login page
- Select “Student” as User Type
- Enter your username: Your username is the CWU username you use to log in to a campus computer.
- Enter your password: You have just set a new password by following the instructions at the “Forgot Your Password” link.

eTutoring is a free service available seven days a week. The eWriting Lab lets you submit a draft of your paper, request specific feedback, and receive a tutor’s response within 24–48 hours. Live Tutoring offers one-on-one sessions with a certified tutor in a fully interactive, virtual environment. Log in to view the Tutor Schedule by subject area. With eQuestions, you can submit a specific question to an eTutor and receive a response within 48 hours (often sooner).
