Feedback from High School Partners

- More collaboration with CWU for student resources (admissions, financial aid, library, tutoring resources, CWU ID cards)
- Opportunities to bring CiHS students to CWU or bring the CWU experience to them – meaningful campus visits and engagement
- Concerns about hiring and retaining qualified teachers
- Credentials/certificates for students upon high school completion (WA 45/general education)
- Transcript alignment and access to student records – data sharing
- Professional development and training opportunities for high school teachers and staff

What's next?

- New counselor and administrator trainings available starting in fall
- Monthly online meetings/podcasts from CWU faculty and staff to support students, teachers, and high school staff
- Our office will start reaching out to schedule collaborative conversations between our team and regional high school partners to align program improvement
- Our team is in conversations with university departments now to develop meaningful campus engagement and resources for CiHS students and teachers.
- We are also working with advising and admissions around creating simplified general education resources our to share withour schools.
