It is the student's responsibility to verify that they are meeting graduation requirements while enrolled in Running Start. Students should meet regularly with their high school counselor each term regarding high school graduation requirements.

For purposes of transcripts credits conversion, Easton School will allow .2 Carnegie Units for each one (1) credit. Example: 5 CWU credit class = 1 Carnegie Unit or Easton credit.

College coursework of any kind (Running Start, enrichment) must have advanced approval of the Principal or Counselor in order to qualify for Easton School credit towards graduation.

NOTE: English 101 must be taken and passed with a C- or better before ANY other CWU English course. This is a Central Washington University requirement.
