It is the student's responsibility to verify that they are meeting graduation requirements while enrolled in Running Start. Students should meet regularly with their high school counselor each term regarding high school graduation requirements.

For purposes of transcripts credits conversion, Thorp High School will allow .2 Carnegie Units for each one (1) credit. Example: 5 CWU credit class = 1 Carnegie Unit or THS credit.

Course content equivalency in some cases will require multiple CWU classes be taken to satisfy a THS required subject.

College coursework of any kind (Running Start, enrichment) must have advanced approval of the Principal or Counselor in order to qualify for THS credit towards graduation.

NOTE: English 101 must be taken and passed with a C- or better before ANY other CWU English course. This is a Central Washington University requirement.
