Foreign Language	Any 2 Foreign Language courses (same language and sequential 10 credits.) CLEP test option? STAMP test at WHS.

High School and Beyond	Students are required to complete high school and beyond plan with WHS counselor	

It is the student's responsibility to verify that they are meeting graduation requirements while enrolled in Running Start. Students should meet regularly with their high school counselor each term regarding high school graduation requirements.

For purposes of transcripts credits conversion, Wahluke High School will allow .2 Carnegie Units for each one (1) credit. Example: 5 CWU credit class = 1 Carnegie Unit or WHS credit.

Course content equivalency in some cases will require multiple CWU classes be taken to satisfy a WHS required subject. College coursework of any kind (Running Start, enrichment) must have advanced approval of the Principal or Counselor in order to qualify for WHS credit towards graduation.

NOTE: English 101 must be taken and passed with a C- or better before ANY other CWU English course. This is a Central Washington University requirement
