High School Subjects	College Equivalent
English	English 101 , or any course in the English or Communication Department above the 100 level. Students who intend to complete 11th and 12th grade English through RS must take Eng 101 AND one other course above that level. It is recommended students take an English course in BOTH their junior and senior years.
US History	History 143 or 144
Civics/Sr. Social Studies	Political Science 210
Math	Math-any course above the 101 level : Algebra 2, MTH 99 * Math courses taken below the 101 level will not be paid for by the district.
Science	Any course in the following departments at the 100 level or above: Biology , Chemistry , Environmental Science , Geology , Physics .
PE	Any course in the following departments at the 100 level or above: Physical Education , Dance , Nutrition 101
Fine Arts	Any course in the following department at the 100 level or above: Art , Dance , Music , Theater . *Most courses are 3 or 4 credits.
Career and Technical Education	Any course in the following departments at the 100 level of above: Business , Computer Science , Information Technology .
