CERHS Graduation Requirement	Course Requirement and / or College Course Equivalent College Courses are through Central Washington University unless otherwise noted.
Junior/Senior English	<a href="#">ENG 101 - 109, 111</a> <b>NOTE: English 101 (pass with a C- or better) must pass with a C- or better, must be taken before ANY other English course. This is a Central Washington University Requirement.</b>
Fine Arts	Any Fine, Visual or Performing Art Course
Mathematics	Algebra I, Geometry and Algebra II must be completed through the high school Can take CWU <a href="#">MATH 100C</a> (Intermediate Algebra), at student's expense, in lieu of Algebra II
Science	Any College Level Science Course, to include one Algebra-based science course (options are: <a href="#">CHEM 111, 112, 113, 181, 182, 183</a> all w/labs, <a href="#">PHYS 101, 103, 109, 111, 112, 113, 121, 122, 123, 181, 182, 183</a> )
Washington State History	<a href="#">HIST 301</a> or <a href="#">POSC 230</a>
United States History	<a href="#">HIST 143</a> or <a href="#">HIST 144</a>
World History	<a href="#">HIST 103</a>
Civics/American Government	<a href="#">POSC 210</a>
Contemporary World Problems	<a href="#">ECON 101, 102, 210</a> ; <a href="#">SOC 101</a> ; <a href="#">GEOG 101</a> ; <a href="#">WGSS 201, 250, 302</a>
Career and Technical Education	Any <a href="#">Business, Computer, IT, Engineering</a> , Technical or other course agreed upon with the High School Counselor, in advance

It is the student's and parent's responsibility to verify the student's classes are meeting graduation requirements while enrolled in Running Start or similar college courses.

For purposes of transcripts credits and conversion, Cle Elum-Roslyn High School will allow .2 Carnegie Units for each one (1) credit. Example: 5 CWU credit class = 1 Carnegie Unit or 1 CERHS credit.

College coursework of any kind (Running Start, Enrichment) must have advanced approval of the Principal or Guidance Counselor in order to qualify of CERHS credit towards graduation. Running Start students should see their counselor regarding class equivalencies for college admissions.
