HIGH SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS	CENTRAL WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY COURSE EQUIVALENCIES	COLLEGE CREDIT NEEDED
CAREER TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION (CTE)/OCC ED	Any <a href="#">business</a> , <a href="#">computer</a> , technical, or other occupational class as agreed on with high school counselor.	
ENGLISH	One five credit <a href="#">English</a> course must be taken for <u>both</u> junior and senior year.	
FINE ARTS	Any <a href="#">Art</a> , <a href="#">Theater Art</a> , or <a href="#">Music</a> class that the student is eligible for per university requirements. Please note this can also include dance classes as long as they are not being used for PE credits.	
HEALTH	<a href="#">Health education 101</a> *Note- This class is only 4 credits at CWU	
MATHEMATICS	*must be <a href="#">100</a> and above to count for high school credit *must be <a href="#">101</a> level or above for RS to pay tuition *must start at math level that entrance testing determines	
PHYSICAL EDUCATION	<a href="#">Any PE class</a> that the student is eligible for per university requirements. Please note this can also include dance classes as long as they are not being used for art credit. In addition, students can meet proficiency with the fitness plan or fitness assessment.	
SCIENCE	Any science class that the student is eligible for per university requirements (I.E. <a href="#">CHEM</a> , <a href="#">GEOL</a> , <a href="#">PHYS</a> )	
US HISTORY	For a full year of high school credit pick one of the two- <a href="#">History 143</a> or <a href="#">History 144</a>	
GOVERNMENT	<a href="#">Political science 210</a> - American Politics	
HISTORY ELECTIVE	<a href="#">Any history class above 100 level</a>	
MODERN WORLD HISTORY	<a href="#">History 103</a>	
WASHINGTON STATE HISTORY	<a href="#">History 301</a> - Pacific Northwest History- only if needed
