PE	Any PE, PEF, or DNCE <i>Most PE classes are 1 credit. 5 PE classes/credits = 1 EHS credit; 3 PE classes/credits = .6 EHS credit</i>
Consumer & Family Issues	FCS 371 or FIN 174
CTE	Any: ACCT, AMDG, BME, BUS, CDFS, CMGT, COM, CS, ECON, EET, EMS, ETSC, FCS, FIN, IT, LAJ, MET, MSL, NUTR, SHM, etc.
Art	FILM 150, MUS 101, 102, or 103, DNCE 161, TH 101 or 107, or any ART class, including Art History courses.

1 CWU Credit = .20 EHS Credit

Example: 5 CWU Credit = 1.0 EHS Credit

For purposes of transcript conversion, Ellensburg High School posts .2 Carnegie Units for each one (1) college credit.
Example: 5 credit CWU class = 1 Carnegie Unit or EHS credit.

It is the student's responsibility to verify that they are meeting graduation requirements while enrolled in Running Start

Course content equivalency in some cases will require two (2) CWU classes to be taken to satisfy an EHS required subject. College coursework of any kind (Running Start, Enrichment) must have advanced approval of the counselor in order to qualify for EHS credit toward graduation. Running Start students must meet with their counselor each quarter prior to registering for Running Start classes.
