

2019-2020 Financial Aid Revision Request Budget Increase for Department of Aviation

The deadline to submit documentation for 2019-2020 budget increases is August 1, 2019. Department of Aviation increases received after the deadline will be processed in the order received and cannot be guaranteed to be completed before the start of fall quarter.

The Cost of Attendance (COA) is an estimated budget comprised of anticipated tuition, fees, room and board, books and supplies, transportation, and a personal expense allowance. Department of Aviation “education-related expenses” can be added to the student budget if a properly documented request is submitted to the Financial Aid Office.

Additional Fees for Flight Training Device labs required in Flight Officer Specialization (4th Year) and are department approved electives for the Commercial Pilot specialization: AVP 444 - \$1,415, AVP 445 - \$1,290, AVP 489 - \$2,345

AVP 104 and AVP 308 are not automatically included in the annual budget increase because they can be taken during either the regular academic year or summer. Students are required to submit a request in writing after registering for these courses. Each of these flight labs cost \$1,000.

Policy requirements for Department of Aviation budget increases are listed as follows:

1. Budgets will only be increased for the Department of Aviation Fees associated with annual course plan as listed on the 2019-2020 budget as outlined on page one of this document.
2. Transfer students' budget increases will be processed based on actual enrollment and annual program plan provided by the Department of Aviation (see below).
3. To request a budget increase, students must first register for Aviation courses and submit a signed copy of this form to the Financial Aid Office. **Deadlines: Fall – August 1st, Winter – November 1st, Spring – February 1st, Summer – May 1st.**
4. Repeated Courses: Students must adhere to the Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) policy: <http://www.cwu.edu/financial-aid/satisfactory-academic-progress-sap-policy>; Please note, this may be different from academic program requirements.
5. No budget increases will be processed for flight lab “no-show” and unexcused absences.
6. In cases of inclement weather, the students must show proof of additional costs for time spent on flight simulator, etc.
7. Students are responsible for managing all funding associated with the Department of Aviation increases. Additional requests will not be processed for mismanagement of funds.
