ALSO FOR SINGLE SUBJECT (K-12) ENDORSEMENT PROGRAMS

Pre-Admission Phase (17 credits)

EFC 250 must be taken first or with the first course(s).

Apply to Teacher Certification Program (TCP) by the end of EFC 250.

EFC 250 - Introduction to Education (4cr)

EFC 320 is a pre/co-requisite for several courses in the Pedagogy Phase.

EFC 320 – Multicultural Education (3cr)

These courses may be taken any time before EFC 470 Student Teaching and do not require full admission to the Teacher Certification Program.

EDBL 401 – Principles of Educating Linguistically Diverse Students (3cr)

EDSE 302 – Introduction to Students with Exceptionalities (3cr)

PSY 314 – Human Development & the Learner (4cr)

Pedagogy Phase (17 credits)

Prerequisites for all courses in the Pedagogy Phase:

- Full admission to Teacher Certification Program and
- Successful completion of EFC 250 with at least a C.

EFC 315 must be taken before or during EFC 340 and EFC 416.

EFC 340 and EFC 416 should be taken together.

EFC 315 – Educational Assessment (3cr)

EFC 340 – Methods of Teaching (3cr)

EFC 416 – Educational Technology (3cr)

*EFC 330: **Requires separate application process prior to normal registration times. Check deadlines.**

- Requires current WSP/FBI fingerprint clearance & purchase of liability insurance.

Clinical Practice Phase (16 credits)

EFC 460 **must** be taken the quarter before EFC 470. It may be taken with Pedagogy Phase courses.

EFC 460 – Pedagogy Capstone (2cr)

EFC 470: **Apply for student teaching two quarters before. Check deadlines.**

Prerequisites for EFC 470: WSP/FBI fingerprint clearance, Liability insurance, West E/NES exam

EFC 470 – Student Teaching Secondary (14cr)
