Meeting was called to order at 3:13 p.m.

Melissa moved to approve the May 7, 2018. Holly seconded, and agenda was approved.

Chair update - Student journalist has contacted Becky about the new Gen Ed program. He would like a list of all the approved courses.

Student petition – Student would like to use ANTH 314 for General Education. Took two courses from same category in natural sciences. The Academic Advisor did not explicitly tell the student they shouldn't take from the same category. There are no advising notes one way or another. This is a transfer student, so they didn't take UNIV 101. Student is graduating summer quarter. The student was advised on April 30th of this deficiency. Took ANTH 110 fall quarter 2015 and is currently enrolled in ANTH 314. Lori moved to approve the student petition. John seconded. 5 yes, 4 no, 1 abstain. Motion passed.

Jim asked for the new General Education program if will they be able to show courses available if they have already taken a course from the same department. Lindsey indicated that no, so far, they have not been able to find a way to program for this.

Policy – The committee worked on going through the draft policy and procedure the subgroups developed.

Eric Cheney talked about the implementation report. The GEITF has three scenarios for the teach out. Scenario one is to not allow any students to switch programs. Scenario two students could switch and three is to force everyone to switch. Eric asked the committee for their thoughts on these scenarios. Jim moved to endorse option #2. John seconded, and motion was approved with 1 abstention.

Next week the committee will focus on student petitions to see if that can get ready for the May 30th faculty senate meeting.
